The Blue Sea Lake Watershed Association will hold its 12th Annual General Meeting on Saturday, October 17th from 10am to Noon. Because of the pandemic, this year's AGM will be held virtually, using Zoom, and will be limited to Members who have paid their 2020 Membership dues (\$20 per person).

The installation of jute tarps is now completed. However, we should not forget about other activities of the Association. This is certainly the case with the milfoil beds demarcation program using yellow buoys and signaling buoys.

This year, a total of 222 yellow buoys and 18 signaling buoys were installed. They must be removed this fall, no later than mid-October. The work is done on the water, typically 2 persons in a ± 16 foot aluminum motorized boat. The more teams there are, the less time it takes to do the job; so if you want to enjoy the great outdoors one last time on the water, make yourself known. We need boats and people.
